<p>Legal basis for processing your personal data</p>	<p>The legal basis for the collection and processing of your personal data is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • for administration and training programme delivery: that it is necessary to fulfil the role of training and playing matches • for dealing with medical needs: that you have given your explicit consent or in the members vital interests. • in all other cases: that it is necessary for our legitimate interests which are to build a programme to encourage participation in cricket and does not prejudice or harm rights and freedoms of adult members, parents / guardians or the children that join the club.
<p>Your right to withdraw consent</p>	<p>Where you have given your consent to any processing of personal data, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had consent prior to your withdrawing it.</p>
<p>Location of your personal data</p>	<p>The Club will keep your personal data within the European Economic Area.</p>
<p>How long we will keep your personal data for</p>	<p>We will not retain your personal data for longer than is reasonable and necessary for the purposes for which it was collected. We shall retain your personal data for such time as you are registered with Shepherdswell Cricket Club as a member.</p> <p>2 years after you cease to be a member of Shepherdswell Cricket Club or play an active part in the club, we shall delete your data.</p>
<p>Your rights in respect of your personal data</p>	<p>You have the right of access to your personal data and, in some cases, to require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it, and the right of data portability.</p>
